

kwh Rates-Schedule 'A'

residential/farm single phase

availability: Available to residences, farms, public buildings and schools subject to the established rules and regulations of the cooperative. The installation of single phase motors requiring in excess of 260 amperes starting current subject to prior approval of the cooperative.

type of service: Single phase, 60 cycle, at available secondary voltages.

monthly rate:

Facilities Charge:	\$22.00
Energy Assistance Charge:	\$.40
Renewable Energy Charge:	\$.05
All kwh@	\$.1220

minimum charges: The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$22.00 plus applicable taxes for services requiring 10 kva or less of transformer capacity. For services requiring more than 10 kva of transformer capacity, the minimum excess monthly facilities charge shall be increased at the rate of \$1.25 plus applicable taxes for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. Payments of the excess minimum facilities charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kWh in accordance with the foregoing rate.

terms of payment: The monthly rate above is calculated at the net rate and assumes the net payment will be made by the 21st day of the billing month or by the Monday following the 21st day of the billing month when the 21st day of the billing month is on a weekend. Bills paid after the 21st day of the billing month will be charged the gross rate which will be the net rate plus 10% of the first \$100 of the net billing and 5% of the remainder of the net bill.

utility taxes: As specified by the State of Illinois, a Public Utility Tax will be added to the above energy charges and to the monthly Wholesale Power Adjustment charges. The cooperative may add future applicable taxes imposed on the consumer by any taxing authority.

energy assistance and renewable energy charges: As specified by the State of Illinois, each account shall be assessed \$.40 for an Energy Assistance charge and \$.05 for a Renewable Energy charge.

wholesale power adjustment: The cooperative reserves the right to apply a Wholesale Power Adjustment depending on purchased power cost from the wholesale power provider. Said adjustment shall be based on the amount by which the actual purchased power cost exceeds or is less than \$0.0765 per kilowatt-hour purchased from cooperative's supplier times 1.0695 to adjust for line loss.
